## SUSTAINABILITY EDUCATION

**GRANTS** • Up to \$20,000 over two years for faculty members to create new courses and programs to advance and diversify sustainability education.

## **SUSTAINABILITY FELLOWSHIPS** •

Collaborate with other faculty members who are designing new sustainability courses and programs through a Sustainability Education Grant.

## **CLIMATE EDUCATION GRANTS •**

Up to \$5,000 for faculty members to incorporate climate change content into existing courses.

## **CLIMATE TEACHING CONNECTOR •**

Integrate climate content into undergraduate classes by connecting with climate change and climate justice experts.

### CAMPUS AS A LIVING LAB •

UBC's Campus as a Living Lab (CLL) initiative provides a collaborative framework and up to \$50,000 in seed funding for faculty and staff to test new ideas on campus.
